SYNOPSIS: This bill would provide that there shall be
electronic voting equipment capable of meeting the
needs of disabled or alternative language voters
installed in each ward, precinct, or beat.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To provide that there shall be electronic voting
equipment capable of meeting the needs of disabled or
alternative language voters installed in each ward, precinct,
or beat.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. On or before January 1, 2007, and subject
to the receipt of sufficient HAVA federal funds pursuant to
the Help America Vote Act, the Secretary of State shall have
installed, pursuant to the authority granted under Article 2,
Chapter 24, Title 17, Code of Alabama 1975, electronic voting
equipment capable of meeting the needs of disabled or

1 alternative language voters in each ward, precinct, or beat in
2 the state. The Secretary of State shall promulgate rules and
3 regulations necessary to implement and administer the
4 provisions of this act.

5 Section 2. The provisions of this act are severable.
6 If any part of this act is declared invalid or
7 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part
8 which remains.

9 Section 3. This act shall become effective
10 immediately following its passage and approval by the
11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
