contribution made by one person in the name of another person, 1 2 or for any candidate, principal campaign committee, or political action committee to knowingly accept a contribution 3 made by one person in the name of another person; provided, 4 5 however, that nothing in this chapter would prohibit any person from soliciting and receiving contributions from other 7 persons for the purpose of making expenditures to a candidate, 8 political campaign committee, political action committee, or 9 elected state or local official required to file reports 10 pursuant to Section 17-5-8. 11 "(b) It shall be unlawful for any political action committee to make a contribution to any other political action 12 13 committee, other than a principal campaign committee." 14 Section 2. This act shall become effective 15 immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 16
